
**DECISION**

J. Hartling (Chief Adjudicator):

1. The Complainant is seeking an extension of time to disclose documents to other parties.
2. The Complainant advised she is seeking information from ATIPP and has not received a date from ATIPP as to when the information will be provided.
3. The Respondent opposes the application advising the complaint was filed three years ago thereby providing time to produce documents.
4. I note that the matter was only referred to the Panel on February 21, 2023.

5. The Respondent requests that, should the application for extension be granted, a breakdown of the damages claimed by the Complainant should be provided to the Respondent.
6. Since the documents the Complainant is seeking may assist in providing a breakdown of the damages claimed, no order will be given for a breakdown at this time.
7. It is open to the Respondent to make a request for a breakdown at a later date.
8. The Complainant's application is granted.
9. The Complainant will disclose all relevant documents to other parties November 1, 2023.
